*Re: Request for Data*

In response to the FERC Order Directing the Submission of Data (Docket No. RC09-3-000, see attached), issued on December 18, 2008, and as a follow-up to the NPCC letter, to TOs and TOPs, dated December 19, 2008 NPCC is requesting that each U.S. entity, within its footprint, please supply the following information:

To be completed by TO, TOP and DP:

- (a) Listing of all transmission facilities 100kV and above. Data requested includes: Substation Name; individual bus kV; associated Balancing Authority; associated Transmission Owner; associated Transmission Operator; transmission lines greater than 100 kV associated with that Substation; summer normal rating of transmission lines; associated transformers connected to the bus; transformer capacity rating; associated generator station name (if applicable); generator unit name (if applicable) and Generator Owner (if applicable).

To be completed by GO and GOP:

- (b) Listing of each generating unit with a gross nameplate rating of 20 MVA or above (or aggregate gross nameplate plant rating of 75 MVA) that is directly connected to a 100 kV and above transmission facility. The data request includes: Generation Station Name; Generator Unit Name; Balancing Authority; Generator Owner; Generating Operating; Gross Nameplate rating; 100 kV and above interconnection bus name; 100 kV and above interconnection bus kV and associated Transmission Owner.


Attached please find a set of templates to be used to furnish this data for both New York and New England Areas. Included in each template is a sample of the data to be supplied highlighted in yellow.

Submittal of this data will meet the requirement contained in the December 19, 2008 letter to supply NPCC an impact assessment of adopting the 100 kV and above definition. As indicated in that letter implementation plans necessary for full compliance with the NERC standards, of those facilities 100 kV and above, are to be submitted to and approved by NPCC before May 1, 2009. NPCC will be distributing additional information related to the submittal of those implementation plans by the end of January 2009.

This information will be included in the response to the FERC order that is scheduled to be submitted to FERC on **January 22, 2009**. In order to meet this schedule, please furnish this information to NPCC (Trey Kirkpatrick at [tkirkpatrick@npcc.org](mailto:tkirkpatrick@npcc.org)) by **January 9, 2009**.
