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**1. Introduction**

#### **4. NERC/NPCC/NYISO Activities**

##### **4.1 NYISO 2008/2009 NERC/NPCC Compliance Program Status**

A. Elacqua reviewed the latest requirements for which the NYISO has submitted data and is in full compliance.

Mr. Appelbaum discussed issues related to several proposed NERC standards and interpretations.

##### **4.3 NPCC Compliance Committee Report**

Mr. Appelbaum discussed several NERC compliance issues.

##### **4.4 Other NERC, NPCC and NYISO Activities**

Mr. Elacqua reported that an on-site audit will be conducted by NPCC, NERC and FERC representatives on August 18 -21 with respect to NYISO compliance with six NERC CIP standards. He will report the outcome of the audit at the next RCMS meeting [AI #115-1].

#### **5. NYSRC 2009 Reliability Compliance Monitoring Program**

##### **5.1 2009 Compliance Monitoring Program Summary Update**

Mr. Adamson reviewed updates to the 2009 Compliance Monitoring Program summary.

##### **5.2 Operating Report for July 2009**

Mr. Elacqua reviewed the July 2009 operating report. Mr. Appelbaum requested an explanation of the CPS1 and CPS2 decreases shown in the report. Mr. Elacqua will respond to this question at the September meeting [AI #115-2]. The RCMS found the NYISO to be in full compliance with Measurement K-M2d for July 2009.

##### **5.3 Pre-Seasonal Fault Duty Assessment (E-M6a)**

The 2009 Pre-Seasonal Fault Duty Assessment report, presented at the July meeting, has been supplemented in accordance with RCMS compliance requirements. The RCMS found the NYISO to be in full compliance with Measurement E-M6a pending NYISO Operating Committee approval of the technical findings in the report. (Later in the day the OC approved the technical findings of the study, and therefore the NYISO is in full compliance with E-M6a.)

#### **5.4 System Data Requirements (C-M11)**

A C-M11 certification form was provided, including generator survey results of governor response data. Following RCMS review, RCMS found the NYISO to be in full compliance with Measurement C-M11, pending revision of the certification form. (After the meeting the NYISO submitted a revised form in accordance with RCMS requirements.)

#### **5.5 Review of August Compliance Assessments (E-M8)**

Mr. Adamson reviewed compliance requirements for E-M8. Compliance documentation is due September 1, 2009.

### **6. Determination of Resource Availability C-R2/C-M5 Non-Compliance**

As background, on July 9, 2009 the NYISO provided RCMS with a copy of a C-M5 non-compliance letter issued to a Market Participant (identifying information redacted). The Market Participant was also sanctioned by the NYISO for over-selling capacity in violation of NYISO tariffs and procedures. The letter requested the Market Participant to provide mitigation measures to ensure future compliance.

On August 6, 2009 the NYISO provided the following pertinent information, as summarized by Mr. Adamson, in response to RCMS questions at or since its last meeting:

- The incorrect outage data was submitted to the NYISO between January 2008 and April 2008.
- The data was found in error by the NYISO MMU in October 2008.
- RCMS was notified about the data error on July 9, 2009.
- As of August 6 the Market Participant had not yet provided mitigation measures.

Because 2008 outage data was not used for the 2009 IRM Study (the study used 2003-2007 data), the data error had no impact on the NYCA 2009 IRM results. Because a violation of Measurement C-M5 arises when erroneous outage data is not identified before it is used in NYSRC or NYISO study applications and the data was found to be in error before it was used in an IRM study (per RRS' C-M5 January 2009 interpretation), RCMS concluded that the NYISO did not violate C-M5. A report on these RCMS findings will be prepared for tomorrow's EC meeting [AI #115-3].

## 7.1 Implementation Status Updates of Recommendations #1-#7

The following table provides recommendation and status excerpts from the RCMS C-M5 Report:

7	Joint NYISO/ICS EFOR trend analysis	ICS decision to continue to use 5-year historic EFOR as the basis for the study. NYISO to continue to provide existing graphs and analysis as requested by ICS going forward. Complete.
