TITLE: GENERATOR AVAILABILITY DATA SYSTEM (GADS) TRAINING

Procedure Statement

NYISO should provide Generator Availability Data System (GADS) Reporting Training for Market Participants to provide the knowledge necessary to enter data for compliance with the NYISO ICAP Market Operating Reporting System described in the NYISO ICAP Manual.

This training is necessary to comply with New York State Reliability Council (NYSRC) Reliability Rule C-R2, Measurement C-M4 to provide Training programs for Installed Capacity Providers that focus on proper generating unit outage data collection and reporting methods for submission of accurate data to the NYISO.

Implementation and Responsibilities

Market Training Supervisor or Trainer

- Develop an Annual GADS Training Plan to achieve compliance with NYSRC Reliability Rule C-R2, Measurement C-M4.
- Develop Training materials for as required by the Training Plan
- Schedule GADS Training.
- Conduct training (i.e. live) or if on-line media is being used, post the training materials in the proper training media for GADS Training.
- Ensure completed GADS Training is documented.

Manager, Auxiliary Market Operations or Delegate

- Review and Approve Annual GADS Training Plan.
- Review and Approve GADS Training Materials.
- Identify weaknesses in GADS Market Participant data entries that could be resolved through Training.
- Identify changes to the NYISO GADS Reporting System that would require training for data entrants.
- Assign Subject Matter Expertise to assist with questions during the conduct of GADS training or supplement Market Training to conduct the training as needed.




Procedure

- The Market Trainer shall develop a GADS Training Plan by January 31 identifying the following:
 - Topics for GADS Training for entry level Market Participants

- Topics for re-training if Auxiliary Market Operations identifies data entry weaknesses or changes to reporting requirements that require training
- The Manager, Auxiliary Market Operations or Delegate shall approve the GADS Training Plan.
- The Market Trainer shall develop GADS Training materials.
- The Manager, Auxiliary Market Operations or Delegate shall review and approve the GADS Training materials.
- The Market Training Supervisor shall schedule GADS Training.
- The Market Training Supervisor shall notify the Market Participants of the training schedule.
- The Market Trainer shall document training attendance.
- The Market Trainer shall conduct the GADS Training
- Auxiliary Market Operations shall provide a Subject Matter Expert to assist with answering questions during the conduct of the training.
- Auxiliary Market Operations shall supplement the Training Group with instructing the GADS Training as needed.
- GADS Training Plan, Material and attendance sheets will be retained pursuant to NYISO policy.
