NYSRC Mission

- The mission of the *NYSRC* is to promote and preserve the *reliability* of the *New York State Power System* (“*NYS Power System*”) in the *New York Control Area* (“*NYCA*”).
- This mission includes developing, maintaining, and from time-to-time, updating the Reliability Rules which shall be complied with by the *NYISO* and *Market Participants*.
- The *NYSRC* fulfills this mission through its focus on maintaining the *reliability* of the *New York State Bulk Power System* (“*NYS Bulk Power System*”).

NYSRC BPS Definition

- Inconsistent with NPCC's BPS definition
 - Different elements identified
 - NPCC's BPS definition under FERC review
- Preliminary agreement that NYSRC should
 - Adopt NPCC's BPS definition
 - Revise NYSRC RRs to clarify facility list association
 - Develop facility list definition(s)
 - Revise mission focus statement

Status Report

- NYISO has provided A1, A2, A10 & ATR facility lists, and NYISO's interpretation of which facility list is associated with each rule
- RRS has reviewed each RR and identified which set of facilities (by NYSRC definition) are associated with each rule

Action Plan

- Develop NYCA facility list(s) associated with the application of the “more specific/more stringent” New York-Specific Reliability Rules & Local Reliability Rules
- These NYCA facility list(s) will be independent of NERC & NPCC’s ≥ 100 kV bright line BES facilities but may include some of those facilities

Action Plan

- General approach is to adopt NYISO's Annual Transmission Review (ATR) facility list as the basis for all NYSRC Reliability Rules
 - Develop inclusion/removal criteria for ATR list
 - Develop criteria for exceptions to ATR list
 - NPCC A-10 for NYSRC protection rules
 - Other
- RRS/NYISO meetings to develop ATR & exception criteria
