The list of exceptions to the NYSRC Reliability Rules shall be reviewed by the NYISO annually. The scope of the review is to verify that the basis for each exception is still valid, but not to question the original justification for the exception. In addition, a Transmission Owner, at any time may request a review by the NYISO for removal of any of its current exceptions. The NYISO shall notify the NYSRC when it has determined that an exception is no longer valid and document the reasons for its determination. If the NYSRC concurs with the NYISO's determination, the exception will be discontinued and the NYISO and NYSRC will revise their list of exceptions accordingly.

Annual NYISO Review of Exceptions

The list of exceptions to the NYSRC Reliability Rules shall be reviewed by the NYISO annually. **In addition, a Transmission Owner can request a NYISO review of any of its own exceptions at any time.**

The scope of the review is to verify that the basis for each exception is still valid, but not to question the original justification for the exception. The NYISO shall notify the NYSRC when it has determined that an exception is no longer valid **or required** and document the reasons for its determination.

If the NYSRC concurs with the NYISO's determination, the exception will be discontinued and the NYISO and NYSRC will revise their list of exceptions accordingly.
