Yes, Con Edison supports this proposed language change and is appreciative of the suggestions put forth by the proponents. We just need to add the phrase in blue "within the capability year" because the intent of our original language was not to wait until the annual test to test these critical components. I suspect this is acceptable to the generator folks.

If we are all together on the changed language, my suggestion is that RRS recommend to the EC that PR #99 be approved at the July meeting without reposting for another 45 days.

G-M3:

Each Blackstart Provider shall develop appropriate procedures to ensure those blackstart facilities under its control are able to perform their intended functions. Each Blackstart Provider shall complete a successful test of the startup and operation of each of its Blackstart Facilities included in the NYCA SRP in each Capability Year to demonstrate that its Blackstart Facilities can perform their intended functions in accordance with the procedures required in Measurement G-M1. Each Blackstart Provider shall provide documentation of these test results to the appropriate entity in accordance with NYISO and transmission owner procedures. All Blackstart Providers shall identify and maintain a list of critical components in their facilities (e.g. batteries, diesels,

inverters, etc.) and perform tests [within the capability year](#) to verify the condition of these critical components in accordance with good industry practice. Test results shall be provided to the NYISO upon request. Blackstart Providers shall attend NYISO and transmission owner restoration training as required (G-R1&2).

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
