Mr. Adamson questioned if the new LCR numbers were the outcome of some analytical approach to which Mr. Jiang responded that the final LCR values were part of the new methodology. Mr. Campoli added that the NYISO's Operating Committee has accepted the new recommended numbers.

RCMS found NYISO in full compliance with requirement [A.2: R1]. Motion made by Mr. Shanahan and seconded by Mr. Clayton.

Further, Mr. Gilbraith discussed the March 28th letter: Mr. Adams suggested to include the target LOLE of 0.094 used in the LCR study's alignment analysis be

included in the 2019 LCR report. It was agreed that this be included as an addendum in the March 28 letter. (A reference to the Action Item should be inserted.)
