<u>X</u> Full Compliance	<b>M5.</b> The <i>NYISO</i> certified that, during the previous <i>Capability Year</i> , all Responsible Interface Parties reported required information in accordance with R5 and applicable <i>NYISO</i> procedures, tariffs, and schedules and that the data provided was sufficient to provide a statistically valid estimate of the amount of <i>load</i> reduction that could be expected at the time of an SCR call.
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**Levels of Non-Compliance**

___ Level 1	<b>M5.</b> The <i>NYISO</i> certified that one or more Responsible Interface Parties reported SCR information in accordance with <i>NYISO</i> instructions during the previous <i>Capability Year</i> but did not meet <i>NYISO</i> reporting schedules.
___ Level 2	<b>M5.</b> The <i>NYISO</i> certified that one or more Responsible Interface Parties reported SCR information during the previous <i>Capability Year</i> , but failed to report this information in accordance with <i>NYISO</i> instructions.
___ Level 3	<b>M5.</b> Not applicable.
___ Level 4	<b>M5.</b> The <i>NYISO</i> certified that one or more Responsible Interface Parties failed to report required SCR information during the previous <i>Capability Year</i> .
