2. Approval of Minutes/Action Items

2.1 RCMS Draft Minutes #295 (June) – Mr. Yeomans presented the draft minutes page by page. Mr. Head made the motion to approve the Draft RCMS Minutes #295 as final. Mr. Nichols seconded the motion, none opposed and no abstentions. RCMS approved the Draft RCMS Minutes #295 as final.

Mr. Yeomans reviewed the May 2025 NYISO Operations Report with RCMS members. May 2025 was generally an uneventful month. The peak load for May was 18,206 MWs and that there were sufficient reserves, no Major Emergencies, 0 Alert State, 3 thunderstorm alerts and 1 reserve pickup.

Mr. Head made the motion that RCMS found the NYISO in full compliance for rules [C.5: R1, R3], [C.5: R2] and May Operations Monthly Report [C.8: R1]. Mr. Nichols seconded the motion, none opposed and no abstentions. RCMS found the NYISO in full compliance for all the above mentioned rules.
