NYSRC Requirement(s) for which compliance is being self-certified

R3. The NYISO shall submit a report in the Intervening Year between NYCA Long-Term Resource Adequacy Assessments to inform the NYSRC of any significant updates to assumptions and, if available, findings from the latest final NYISO Comprehensive Reliability Plan or other final NYISO report which may include solutions to reliability needs identified in the Long-Term Resource Adequacy Assessment.
