

New York State Reliability Council – Large Loads Working Group (LLWG)

Meeting Minutes – Meeting #3, March 20, 2026

- Roll Call
 - Richard Bratton took roll call
 - Herb Schrayshuen discussed forms that still needed to be filled out for NYSRC
- Introduction and Request for Additional Agenda Items
 - Richard Bratton requested any additional agenda items, of which there were none
- Review of Action Items List
 - Richard Bratton went over the Action Items List, of which there were 2 items, which were the meeting minutes for LLWG meeting 1 and 2
- Approval of Meeting 1 and 2 Minutes
 - Brian Shanahan moved for approval of the Meeting 1 minutes, Matt Cinadr seconded, the meeting 1 minutes were approved unanimously
 - Matt Cinadr moved for approval of meeting 2 minutes, Brian Shanahan seconded, the meeting 2 minutes were approved unanimously
- Update on Consultant
 - Richard Bratton provided an update on Leka Gjonaj being a consultant for the LLWG for PSC matters, and Reigh Walling being a technical consultant.
 - Chris Wentlent requested that TO participants provide updates on and specific issues related to large loads within their service territories
 - Reigh Walling offered to have his sub-consultant brief the LLWG on issues occurring with large loads in other jurisdictions
- Review Large Load Reliability Risk Document
 - Richard Bratton presented the Large Load Reliability Risk Document
 - Matt Cinadr noted the importance of load shedding, which Herb Schrayshuen noted he would add depth to in PSC comments
- NY PSC Update – Leka Gjonaj
 - Leka Gjonaj presented on the extension request pending at the PSC related to the large load comments, submitted by IPPNY
- PSC Large Load Comments Update
 - Richard Bratton presented the draft PSC comments, as well as the procedure of

them coming from the NYSRC EC.

- There was a discussion on the possibility for entities to use current equipment such as phasor units to understand large loads better
 - The working group discussed whether the NYSRC should discuss cost implications in the PSC comments
 - Lastly, the working group discussed whether to point to certain entities as responsible parties for reliability improvements
- NERC Update
 - Herb Schrayshuen gave an update on NERC activities relating to large loads, including the finalized white paper, and supplemental FERC letter. Herb also gave insight into the registered entity component of NERC's work.
 - FERC ANOPR Summary
 - Richard Bratton presented a screenshot summary of FERC ANOPR comment submissions.
 - NYISO Update
 - Richard Bratton provided an update of large load processes occurring at the NYISO
 - PSEG LI Presentation on Large Loads – PSEG LI
 - PSEG LI presented, with its consultants, its slide deck on how it is dealing with large loads in its service territory
