1. Introduction
 - 1.1. Executive Session (if requested) – None requested
 - 1.2. Requests for Additional Agenda Items – None requested
2. Approval of Minutes/Action Items
 - 2.1. RRS 307 Status Report to Executive Committee - D. Allen provided a brief summary of the RRS307 Status Report provided in the meeting materials.
 - 2.2. RRS 307 Action Items List & Final 2026 RRS Goals - D. Allen reviewed the Action Item list.
 - 2.3. RRS 307 (March 5) Approval of Minutes - D. Allen reviewed the draft minutes. Mr. Shanahan motioned to approve the minutes, D. Interrante seconded; motion carried.
3. NYSRC Reliability Rules Development
 - 3.1. PRR List Outstanding - D. Allen reviewed the PRR Changes list provided in meeting materials.
 - 3.2. PRRs in Development
 - 3.2.1. PRR 153: "Sudden loss of fuel delivery system to multiple solar & wind plants" as Category I & II Design Contingencies in Table B-1
 - 3.2.2. (Eventual) PRR 155: Verification of As-Built IBR Plant Conformance
 - 3.2.3. PRR 157: "Statewide Approach to Large Load Participation in UFLS Programs" - Mr. Allen noted that Martin Paszek is working on the template and anticipates having the first draft for RRS review at the meeting in May.
 - 3.2.4. PRR 158: "Conforming Changes to Multiple Circuit Tower Exemption Language"- Mr. Shanahan reviewed PRR 158 Draft V0, provided in the meeting materials. He noted the proposed changes and the corresponding NERC or NPCC language supporting the need for these changes.
4. Blackstart Study
 - 4.1. Blackstart Resource Availability and Readiness in the Eastern and Western Interconnections - D. Allen provided an explanation to the Worksheet for RRS Responses to "Black Start Study Recommendations" document included in the meeting materials. Mr. Allen requested RRS members use the worksheets to solicit input from their Companies and provide responses to each of the 9 Recommendations from the NERC whitepaper. RRS member responses are due May 22, 2026, and will be compiled brought the RRS for review on June 4, 2026.
5. NYSRC Policy 1, Section 5 "Exception Process" – Approved Changes - D. Allen reviewed the approved changes to Section 5. Noting, the exact date (March 13) when EC approved the changes

will be included in Section 5.1; additionally, the proposed language around exceptions being temporary or permanent was removed.

6. Joint compliance with IBR ride-through requirements: RR B.5 and PRC-029-1 - D. Allen anticipates a draft PRR by June. Language changes are required to align RRB.5 with PRC-029-1.
7. Reliability Rules and Compliance Manual V48 - D. Allen noted the changes have been completed and the updated version of the manual has been sent to EC and will be posted to the NYSRC website following EC review, sometime after 4/10/2026.
8. NERC SARS/Organization Standards
 - 8.1. NERC Standard Tracking - L. Gjonaj reviewed NERC standard balloting summary contained in meeting materials.
9. Reports
 - 9.1. NYSRC EC March 12, 2026, Meeting Report – D. Allen provided a summary of the EC meeting; ICS presented updates including ICF Winter Fuel Constraints Final Report, which noted winter fuel constraints will be included in the upcoming IRM calculation. Updates to Resource Adequacy modeling, improvements included Transmission Security inputs that go into the LCR and IRM. GE changes to MARS have been assessed and do not present a material impact.
 - 9.2. IBR Working Group Status Report – No update at this time.
 - 9.3. Extreme Weather Working Group Meeting Report – D. Allen provided a brief review of the EEWG meeting.
 - 9.4. NYSRC ICS Meeting Report - B. Shanahan provided an update on the ICS meeting noting they are working to determine the correct adjustments needed to correct the opposing deviation between the Parametric results and the Tan45 results. Mr. Shanahan also noted the potential for NYISO to develop a System Topology Update Procedure, to standardize how topographical changes are considered and/or applied.
 - 9.5. Large Load WG Meeting Report –
R. Bratton provided an update, noting the LLWG Work Scope was approved by the EC in March.
