Meeting Minutes – Meeting #4, April 24, 2026

- Roll Call
 - Richard Bratton took roll call
- Introduction and Request for Additional Agenda Items
 - Richard Bratton requested any additional agenda items, of which there were none
- Review of Action Items List
 - Richard Bratton went over the Action Items List, of which there was 1 item, which was the meeting minutes for LLWG meeting 3
- Approval of Meeting 3 Minutes
 - Chris Wentlent moved for approval of the Meeting 3 minutes, Leka Gjonaj seconded, the meeting 3 minutes were approved unanimously
- NY PSC Update – Leka Gjonaj
 - Leka Gjonaj shared that there were no updates at the PSC on Large Loads
- PSC Large Load Comments Update
 - Richard Bratton shared that the draft comments to the PSC were being finalized and shared with the NYSRC EC for approval
- NERC Update
 - Richard Bratton shared an update on NERC publications since the last meeting.
 - A discussion occurred on NERC's threshold for computational loads to be regulated. Ross Altman of the NYISO noted that the 1 MW level would create administrative burden to implement reliability standards. The LLWG decided not to recommend to the NYSRC EC to submit comments, as it was more of an administrative concern than a reliability one.

 - Richard Bratton noted the FERC Order Regarding Intent to Act, which shows a FERC Order is imminent in the coming months
- NYISO Update
 - Richard Bratton noted that there were no updates at the NYISO relating to large loads
