#### 5. Updates to RR C.7 to account for Approved Changes to NYSRC Policy 1, Section 5 “Exception Process” - *Will become PRR161*

- 5.1. *M.Paszek presented the proposed changes to table B-2 and C-2 of the RRC Manual v47. These changes were developed by Con Edison and NYISO and as presented will become PRR 160 and PRR 159, respectively and propose a new term “Emergency response capability” to replace “Operating Reserves”. This new language allows for the inclusion of HVDC energy storage systems giving operations more flexibility with options to move up or down from a Planning and Ops perspective.*

*Mr. Paszek as well as Aaron Markham and Greg Campoli of the NYISO requested that the approval of these rule changes be accelerated such that they are acted on by EC at its June 12 meeting. Motion was made and seconded that these changes be brought to EC at its 5/8 meeting requesting approval and with an abbreviated public comment period to finalize at June EC meeting. Motion approved unanimously.*
