Status Report - RRS Meeting #312 – Thursday, August 6, 2026

◆ **Introduction/RRS Actions Items and Goals**

- No requests for Executive Session or Additional Agenda Items were made;
- Chair issued brief report on July 22nd closed RRS Webex;
- RRS reviewed Action Items list with focus on NPCC Directory 1 issues and Chair requested RRS members to consider taking the lead on developing new PRRs to address any portion of these issues;
- RRS reviewed the draft Meeting Minutes for RRS #310 (June) and unanimously approved the minutes as amended during the meeting; and
- RRS reviewed the draft Meeting Minutes for RRS #311 (July) and unanimously approved the minutes without any changes.

◆ **PRR in Development**

- PRR 153 - TS Planning Performance Requirements - Include "Sudden loss of fuel delivery system to multiple solar & wind plants" as Category I & II Design Contingencies in Table B-1
 - There was a brief discussion NYISO recommendation to discontinue development of PRR, as well as a reminder of EWWG's pending data request to the NYISO and the current tools identified by the NYISO to monitor the impact and frequency of rapid correlated outages of wind and solar: 1) the NYISO's Operations Reports, and 2) the NYISO's System and Resource Outlook Study
- PRR 155 - Verification of AS-Built IBR Plant Conformance
 - Provided overview of proposed changes to RR B.5 to include "as- built" IBR Facilities; and
 - Discussed that PRR 155 will subsume RRS efforts to incorporate references to NERC PRC-029 in the NYSRC documents regard RR B.5 (Agenda Item 6) as well as updates to references to NYISO OATT, Attachment HH and IEEE 2800
- PRR 157 – Mandatory Under-Frequency Load Shedding (UFLS) Design Requirements for Large Load Facilities.
 - Reviewed changes made during the July 22nd RRS Webex (R1-R6), reviewed additional language to R6 (testing frequency) to reference PRC-005, reviewed language added M1- M6, and minor revisions made after July 22nd
 - Discussed whether there was also a need for additional references to Facility Agreement, but this needed to be taken back for review, RRS did not feel this open item should delay posting the rule for comment
 - Motion to recommend EC approve posting draft PRR 157 for public comment passed without objection or abstention
- PRR 161 Updates to RR C.7 Consistent with Updates to Policy 1, Section 5

- Review rule changes to incorporate the review of expiring Exceptions in the current annual process conducted by the NYISO
- Motion to recommend EC approve posting draft PRR 161 for public comment passed without objection or abstention
- PRR 162 and PRR 163 – Modification to the underground cable operating and planning criteria found in Table C-2 and Table B-2, respectively
 - Reviewed status of rule set and motion from RRS #311 regarding changes to PRR 163.
 - RRS had previously moved to recommend the EC post both 162 and 163 for comment pending NYISO's agreement to the changes to PRR 163 requested by Con Edison
 - Con Edison mentioned that RRS should bring ruleset back at the September 3 meeting to allow NYISO time to determine if it agrees with the suggested changes to PRR 163 this language back to determine if they could agree to Con Edison's request

◆ **PRRs for Final Approval**

- PRR 158 – Resolve Difference between NYSRC Reliability Rule Table B-1 and NPCC Directory 1, Table 1, and NERC Standard TPL-001-5.1, Table 1 regarding Multiple Tower Exclusion Criteria
 - Comment Period ran July 31 with no comments received
 - RRS motion to recommend EC issue final approval of PRR 158 passed without objection or abstention

◆ **Other RRS Matters**

- Chair indicated that two RRS member entities still have not completed and returned the worksheet regarding the “Blackstart Resource Availability and Readiness in the Eastern and Western Interconnections, NERC and Regional Entity Staff Study, FERC Staff Observation” (the “Study”); Will reach out separately to these members and then review all responses received with NYISO and discuss next steps with RRS during September and October the RRS meetings.
- Leka Gjonaj presented the NERC Standards Tracking
- Reminded RRS that beginning in September RCMS will precede RRS to accommodate NYISO Request
